23 **Motion was made by Robert Sebald and seconded by Francie Wynalda to approve the**

31  
32 It was requested that we get an update on the status of the Tree Bank. Chairman requested  
33 Gary Schindler to attend next board meeting with a Tree Bank update.

35 VI. Director's Update

37 A. Splash Park Fees

38 Fees for Trailblazer Park were discussed. The Daily fee is \$2.00 per person per day.  
39 Residents will have the option to purchase an annual pass for \$15.00 per family member. The  
40 passes will be a laminated card with all family members listed on one card, or the family  
41 members have the option to obtain individual cards. The first reading was approved by City  
42 Commission the prior week. There was some discussion on how we will patrol the Splash  
43 Park. The maximum number of people inside the Splash Pad is 40 persons.

45 B. Change Meeting to Bi-Monthly

46 There was discussion about changing Park & Recreation Advisory Board Meetings to Bi-  
47 monthly meetings instead of monthly meetings. It was mentioned that the Arbor board  
48 meetings and Park & Recreation Advisory Board Meetings should be held on the same day.

1 **Motion was made by Robert Sebald and seconded by Lynette Swinski that the Parks**  
2 **and Recreation Advisory Board meet Bi-Monthly starting this month. Motion was**  
3 **carried unanimously.**

5 C. Farmers Market

6 The Farmers Market is going extremely well and has proven very successful. It will be  
7 extended for 12 months instead of being seasonal. The Farmers Market does not have a high  
8 turnover and a majority of the vendors are willing to continue their contracts for the year.  
9 There is a waiting list for vendors.
