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23 III. Approval of Minutes May 9, 2016

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28 IV. Senior Center Coordinator's Report –Deb Barr

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30 Items of discussion:

- 31 • A day trip to Winter Park was offered last month which included lunch and a boat  
32 tour. We had 25 seniors register.

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34 V. New Business

- 35 • The City of Lake Mary is partnering with Uber to offer discounts. If someone  
36 uses Uber from Lake Mary and travels to another destination in Lake Mary, they  
37 are given a 20% discount. If someone uses Uber and starts or ends at the Lake  
38 Mary SunRail station, they will be given a 25% discount. This begins July 1,  
39 2016. This may help seniors that need transportation, but a smart phone is  
40 needed to utilize the Uber app.
- 41 • Rebekah Matviak asked if we were familiar with Kane-Fu and if it's something  
42 that our community may be interested in learning. Kane-Fu is basically self-  
43 defense techniques using a cane.

1 VI. Old Business

- 2 • The design plans for the Senior Center expansion are about 90% done. Staff will  
3 be meeting with the architect on Tuesday, June 14. Delays have been due to  
4 changes in mechanical components. The Senior Center could be closed 2-3  
5 months at the most. Possibly do a grand re-opening once it's completed and  
6 partner with the Florida Hospital to showcase an art exhibit.
- 7 • Pamela Bussey met with Compass Research and they would be interested in  
8 sponsoring the event and doing all marketing and provide doctors for seminars.  
9 The EAC needs to determine if/what the fee will be for sponsorship levels and  
10 what will be included as well as fees for tables, seminars, etc. Pam will meet with  
11 Compass Research again to determine if they are interested in being the main  
12 sponsor at \$1,500 which will cover the cost of renting the Events Center.
- 13 • Mike Bley would like to offer another level of sponsorship, possibly at \$250. The  
14 EAC needs to discuss levels of sponsorship and what each would include.  
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
