21 surrounding land being developed.

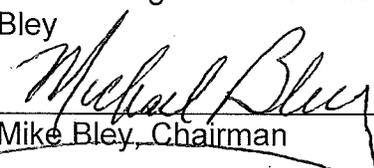

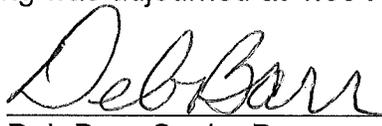
