## New VanPool Grant Program Announced

City of Lake Mary - April 4, 2014

The City of Lake Mary is pleased to announce the establishment of a new grant program designed to get SunRail Commuters to their place of work. The pilot grant program will help offset the cost to employers that wish to participate in the LYNX Agency VanPool Program. The program will cover up to 50% of the monthly lease payment for a Van that will connect an employer's business facility to the Lake Mary SunRail Station Stop. "By utilizing an existing LYNX Program, the real strength of the grant is that employers within the city now have an affordable option to transport their workers door-to-door -- from the train stop, to the workplace", said Mayor David Meador.

Completed grant applications may be submitted for review starting on April 14, 2014, in advance of opening day for the SunRail System. The City Commission will make the final decision regarding the awarding of grants.

The new grant will be open to employers within the City of Lake Mary, and is expected to generate interest from employers located close to Interstate 4. The City allocated enough funds to cover up to twelve (12) grants this fiscal year.
